Morning Session:

Susan Etscheidt opened the meeting and Dean Jean-Marie provided a welcome and opening remarks.

Elana Joram introduced Dr. Mason Kuhn, Assistant Professor – Elementary Education, Department of Curriculum and Instruction, University of Northern Iowa as the winner of the Iowa Academy of Education for his study: *Do Teacher Judgment Accuracy and Teacher Feedback Predict Student Achievement in Elementary and Middle-School Science?* Mason engaged the group in an interactive discussion about his research.

Don Yarbrough introduced Dr. Ariel Aloe, Department of Psychological and Quantitative Foundations, University of Iowa, the 2017 winner of the Thomas N. Urban Award. Dr. Aloe presented a synthesis of his research.

Submit nominations to Marlene Strathe, committee chair person.

Jo Vaske reported on behalf of the Dissertation Award Committee. July 15 deadline. Jo has sent announcements to a list of faculty at the three regents and Drake. Nominations are due July 15. Send nominations to David Bills, committee chair person.

Themed discussion of Iowa-relevant education policies did not occur, given presentation by Dr. Ryan Wise in the afternoon.
